Third Thursday Blackjack Tournaments

Promotion Details

- No beverages will be allowed inside the Tournament area.
- The buy-in for this tournament is **\$75** per player (cash only) per tournament. Each tournament's prize pool is based on the number of paid tournament entrants.
- **The maximum number of entrants for each Tournament is 108.**
- When players are positioned at their table there will be a random draw to determine which seat they are assigned. This will occur during each Round including the Final Table.
- After being seated, each patron will receive \$1K in tournament chips. Tournament chips will hold their face value.
- At the start of each new tournament round the player has the option to do a "dealer add-on" for \$5 for an additional \$500 in chips. Those funds will be allocated to the dealer token pool (each Tournament day).
- The button will start with the actual dealer of the table. After each hand is dealt and bets are taken and paid in turn, the button will move one spot clockwise of the dealer. There will not be a "dead button". The button will move clockwise to the next live player position. The button will only be used to indicate which player is first to bet. After one pass around the table, the button will not stop at the dealer position again, but rather move to the first player clockwise from the dealer. Action (hit/stand) will begin with the position to the immediate player's left of the button. Each player is allowed one bet only.
- Cards will be dealt as in normal Blackjack play (face up) for this Tournament, starting with the first player to the left of the dealer and continuing around the table in normal fashion with the dealer receiving the last card (hole card).
- Eighteen (18) hands will be dealt per session during the Preliminary Round(s). Twenty-four (24) hands will be dealt during the Semi-final Round and the Final Table.
- Each Patron must bet in sequence starting from the first person to the players' left of the dealer button.
- Each Patron has ten (10) seconds to place their wager, if time expires, the player will be forced to make a table minimum bet.

- There will be a “blind bet” during the next to last hand on each table during each Round, including the Final Table. Each player will be given a piece of paper to write their bet down prior to the dealing of the cards. After the hand outcome the bets will be set up using each players bankroll and taken/paid accordingly. Players must have a sufficient amount in their bankroll to make the “blind bet” otherwise the bet will be forfeited.
- There will be a chip count before the last hand is dealt during all Rounds (including the Final Table) to allow for each player to make appropriate bets.

Tournament Structure

- There will be three Preliminary Rounds beginning at 6:00pm with up to thirty-six (36) total entrants in each Round. Players that are eliminated in the first or second Round will have the opportunity to Re-buy for the next available Round up until the start of the third Round based upon availability.
- During the Preliminary Round(s) the top two players at each table advance to the Round of thirty-six (36).
- During the Round of thirty-six (36), the top chip leader (one) at each table will advance to the Semi-final Round.
- The Semi-final Round will contain up to twelve (12) players consisting of the six (6) table winners from the Round of thirty-six (36) plus the top three (3) non-winning chip leaders, and three (3) Wild Card spots.
- The Final Table will consist of the top two (2) players from each Semi-final table plus two (2) Wild Card spots.
- In the event of a tie at any particular table during the Preliminary Round(s), a single card will be dealt to each patron involved and the card(s) highest ranking, as counted in Blackjack, will advance.
- At the end of a session, at any given table, if only one player remains (with at least one chip in their bankroll), then only that one player advances from that given table.
- All tournament chips must be visible on the table layout and kept in front of the player at all times.
- Bets must be made in sequence from the players left of the dealer button.
- Any given patron must have at least one (1) chip remaining to be declared a round winner.
- Table minimum and maximum will be set at \$25 and \$5,000 respectively.
- If Wild Cards are selected, the guests will have five (5) minutes to report to the Tournament area. Upon reception, the ID will once again be checked and tournament eligibility will be verified. The Patron will be tagged as a Wild Card participant.

- Each Player will have one (1) Wild Card entry for each paid entry during each Tournament. If a player's name is drawn who is still in the tournament, that entry will be noted and placed back in the drum. Wild Card entries will be discarded at the end of each Tournament.
- All standard rules of Blackjack apply during the tournament, with the exception that a Blackjack pays 2:1.
- Guests must register by 5:45pm on the day of the Tournament. All guests must report to their session 15 minutes prior to start time to be assigned a table. Late registration could be subject to disqualification.
- Tournament Director's decisions are final.

Rules & Regulations

- Must be a Smokin', Sizzlin, Blazin' or Inferno Red Hot Rewards Club member - membership is free.
- Must be present to win. All prizes must be claimed by the announced winner.
- Must be 21 years of age and provide one of the following current forms of identification: valid driver's license, government photo ID, military photo ID, passport, state issued ID & NHBP Tribal ID. In the event the photo ID does not have the patron's address the following must be provided for verification: current pay stub, or current utility bill. In the event the patron's ID does not have a picture, but has the patron's current address, the patron must provide one of the following for verification: military photo ID, passport, government photo ID.
- It is the responsibility of each Red Hot Rewards Club member participating in the promotion to make sure he/she is using his/her authorized card and that the card is working properly. If a card is not working properly, a duplicate card may be obtained free of charge at any Red Hot Rewards Club booth in the casino.
- Entry into promotion gives FireKeepers Casino Hotel consent to use names and likeness of promotion winners for promotional purposes without further compensation.
- Each winner is responsible for paying any and all taxes on any prizes won and must authorize the deduction of taxes if any.
- FireKeepers Casino Hotel licensed employees are not eligible.
- NHBP Tribal Council and Gaming Commission members are ineligible to participate in any promotions.
- FireKeepers Casino Hotel reserves the right to deny participants, change, modify or cancel the promotion without notice.
- Any dispute in this promotion must be directed to the NHBP Gaming Commission for a resolution process.
