

## BINGO

Bingo is a game of probability in which players mark off (daub) numbers on cards as the numbers are drawn randomly by a caller. Numbers are called until a player daubs all numbers needed to complete the winning pattern. Players compete against one another to be the first to have a winning pattern for the prize or jackpot. The first player with the completed pattern to yell "Bingo" on the last ball called will win the game.

A paper bingo card is 5"x5" and has a total of 25 boxes with 24 numbers plus a "free" space in the center of the card. The five columns of the card are labeled 'B', 'I', 'N', 'G', and 'O' from left to right. The range of printed numbers that can appear on the card is restricted by column, with the 'B' column only containing numbers between 1 and 15, the 'I' column containing only 16 through 30, 'N' containing 31 through 45, 'G' containing 46 through 60, and 'O' containing 61 through 75.

Players may choose between playing paper or electronic. Paper play requires that the player daub all ball calls that are on their paper to achieve the winning pattern. Electronic play is the automated "daubing" of numbers on a tablet with notification to the player to yell "Bingo."
