

Rules & Regulations

- Must be Red Hot Rewards Club Member - membership is free.
 - Must be 21 years of age or older and provide one of the following current forms of identification: valid drivers' license, government photo ID, military photo ID, passport, state issued ID & NHBP Tribal ID. In the event the photo ID does not have the player's address the following must be provided for verification: current pay stub, or current utility bill. In the event the player's ID does not have a picture, but has the player's current address, the player must provide one of the following for verification: military photo ID, passport, government photo ID.
 - Red Hot Credits will expire in sixty (60) days.
 - The top three winners and participation winner do not need to claim their prize at FireKeepers Casino Hotel. They will contact a marketing representative from FireKeepers Casino Hotel to verify their prize. The Red Hot Credits will then be automatically added to winners' Red Hot Rewards Club accounts.
 - Out of respect for our Tribal Members and Culture, face masks representing Native Americans or traditional tribal regalia are excluded from participation. Management reserves the rights to determine acceptable standards for face masks deemed to be offensive or inappropriate.
 - Red Hot Credits are non-transferable.
