Rules & Regulations

Keno Tournament Information:

- Tournament registration will be available in the Keno Booth starting on February 13, 2026, until 3:00pm on the day of the tournament.
- Tournament registration will be available the day of the tournament in the Keno Lounge area from 8:00am to 3:00pm.
- Registration for the tournament is a \$50 Buy-in. Players will receive \$30 loaded onto their tournament card for play in the tournament on the day of the tournament, \$20 goes towards prize pool.
- Tournament will pay prizes of up to (Determined at close of Tournament) for the top five (5) places. See Pay Table in the Promotional Details.
- Players will keep their winnings from tickets purchased and earn the equivalent in points towards the prize pool. Prizes awarded to top five (5) places.
- The Buy-In tournament will begin at 3:00pm. Ticket vending will begin at 9:00am for all races eligible during the tournament.
- The tournament will be held in the Keno Lounge area.
- Additional entries for registered players will be available for purchase until 4:30pm on the day of the tournament.

Tournament Rules:

- *Must be 21 years of age or older and a Red Hot Rewards member to participate.*
- *FKCH employees and NHBPGC employees are not eligible to participate.*
- *Winners must show their RHR card and valid photo identification to claim their prize.*
- *FKCH Keno general rules apply to tournaments.*
- *All winners during the Keno Tournament are accumulating points and need to be present at the end of the tournament to place in the prize pool.*
- *Players may purchase regular tickets of 1 to 10 spots marked, not to exceed \$5 per race. Way tickets are limited to a maximum of 5 ways, not to exceed \$1 per way. Minimum wager for any race is \$1. No Progressive, Penny, Specialty games or side bets will be allowed.*

- *A total of \$30 will be loaded onto the Tournament participant's card for each entry, linked to their tournament ID number for that entry.*
- *All Keno Tournament transactions must be done in the Keno Tournament location.*
- *Points earned will determine winners.*
- *Players may purchase as many entries as they choose, until 4:30pm on the day of the tournament.*
- *It is possible for a single player to win more than one prize.*
- *All Tournament credit must be used during the tournament, as it may not be redeemed for cash or regular Keno play.*
- *The tournament will begin on Friday, March 13, 2026, at 3:00pm. Tournament vending will begin at 9:00am on the day of the tournament.*
- *Thirty (30) games will run at every four (4) minutes for the duration of the tournament.*
- *Official results will be posted within 1 hour of the end of the tournament.*
- *By entering the tournament, participants give permission for their names to be posted on the standing board.*
- *Quit race or early out will not be allowed for tournament play.*
- *Participants will be disqualified if they exceed the \$30 tournament Buy-In on any one entry.*
- *Participants are responsible for ensuring their Tournament ID number is on their ticket.*
- *Odds of winning depend on the total number of entries.*
- *Total prizes for tournament, based on the table below:*

Tournament Prize Pool

Finishing Place	% of Cash Prize Pool - Seeded start \$1000
1	\$400 cash + 30% of parimutuel
2	\$300 + 25% of parimutuel
3	\$200 + 20% of parimutuel
4	\$100 + 15% of parimutuel
5	\$50 property gift card + 10% of parimutuel
Prize pool	\$1050 + parimutuel

- *In the event of a tie, the cash prize amounts will be combined and divided evenly between players, gift card winner will be determined by hat draw.*
- *In the event of non-compliance with the tournament rules, winner forfeits prize and may be disqualified.*
- *Whenever the FKCH Management refuses payment of alleged winnings to a patron or there is otherwise a dispute with a patron regarding a patron's wins or losses from Gaming Activity, and the FKCH Management and the patron are unable to resolve the dispute to the satisfaction of the patron and the dispute involves:*

- *At least five hundred dollars (\$500), the FKCH Management shall immediately notify the NHBP Gaming Office. The NHBP Gaming Office shall conduct whatever investigation it deems necessary and shall determine whether payment should be made; or*
- *Less than five hundred dollars (\$500), the FKCH Management shall inform the patron of his or her right to request that the NHBP Gaming Office conduct an investigation. Upon request of the patron, the NHBP Gaming Office shall conduct whatever investigation it deems necessary and shall determine whether payment should be made.*
- *FKCH Management reserves the right to modify the rules or cancel this event without notice at any time. NHBP Gaming Office approval of any such modification will be required before the modification is effective.*
- *Winners are responsible for paying taxes on all prizes and in assisting in the completion of any applicable tax forms. The IRS and TICS require a W-2G form to be filed on all net Keno winnings of \$1500 or more. Player will be required to provide a valid Social Security number and valid government issued photo identification. Non-resident aliens are subject to a 30% tax withholding to be deducted from gross winnings before payment.*
- *A copy of these rules can be obtained at the Keno booth.*
- *No proxy play. If a pre-registered player does not participate in the tournament, entry fee will be forfeited.*
- *Management reserves all rights.*
